Costs to Connecticut

**\$11,000,000,000**

Instead, we could have provided **health insurance** to all 811,000 children under 18 for **eight years**, or

We could have built 99,000 additional housing units, or

We could have hired 191,000 additional public school teachers for one year (reducing **class size** to nearly **one fifth**), or

We could have paid **seven years worth of Head Start** for **all** 204,000 CT **children** under 5, or

We could have provided 534,000 students (**all CT high school graduates from 2004 to 2020**) four-year scholarships at public universities.
